Athens 30 March - 1 April, 2012

1. The 5th All Greece Iaido Championships 2012 & Grading will take place in Athens, Greece, from 30 March to 1 April 2012. The organization is under the auspices of the Hellenic Kendo Iaido Naginata Federation.

2. The 5th All Greece Iaido Championships 2012 & Grading will include an Iaido Seminar, the All Greece Iaido Championships 2012 and Iaido Grading, Ikkyu & 1-4 Dan.

b. Participation is restricted to HKINF members only.

c. Competition will include Individual matches only; Divisions Mudan (5-1 Kyu) – Shodan – Nidan – Sandan.

d. Preliminary phase, (Pools): Presentation of three predetermined kata within four minutes.

e. Final phase (KO): Presentation of five predetermined kata within six minutes.

Successful Shodan HKINF members should also provide two photos for EKF Yellow Card. Failing to register your successful grading will result in cancelation of your success.

HOW TO COME TO THE VENUE

By car/motorbike/bicycle at the end of Patission str enter Chalkidos str (direction Nea Philadelfia) and immediately after the train bridge turn left into Ionias Avenue, moving in parallel with the train lines. The first street to the right is Neigy str. There is an underground parking below the Sport Center Leonin Lyceum.

By Metro, Station ANO PATISSIA, exiting the station cross Chalkidos str, follow Ionias Avenue (keeping train lines at your left), then as with car. Distance approximately 300m.

By bus, line B8, Bus stop Leonin on Chalkidos str. Follow Evans str and you found Neigy str at the Sport Center Leonin Lyceum. Distance approximately 200m.

From Hotel XENOPHON

Coming out from the hotel walk to to your left, along the metro line. You will found Neigy str to your left at about 1000m.
