Athens 7 - 9 April 2023

1. The 16th All Greece Iaido Championships 2023 will take place from 7 to 9 April 2023 in Athens (see below for venue). The event is organized by Hellenic Kendo Iaido Jodo Naginata Federation, HKINF.

2. In the context of the 16th All Greece Iaido Championships 2023 will be included:

- Iaido Training Seminar,
- Iaido Shinsa, 1 kyu & 1-3 Dan,
- 16th All Greece Iaido Championships 2023 (Individual division- Only Hellenic participation),
- 10th Soryu Iaido Cup 2023 (Team Division – International participation).

9. **Rules and Regulations:**

Competition will take place in accordance with *The Regulations of Iaido Shiai and Shinpan & The Subsidiary Rules of Iaido Shiai and Shinpan, ZNKR October 1996*), with the following clarifications:

a. Competition for 16th AGIC will include Individual divisions only: Mudan – Shodan – Nidan – Sandan – Yondan – Godan. Competition for 10th Soryu Iaido Cup will include a Team Division only.

b. Participation in 16th AGIC is limited to HKINF members only. Participation in 10th Soryu Iaido Cup is open to all members of member-federations of EKF & FIK.

c. For 16th AGIC during Preliminary phase (Pools) competitors will present an enbu of three predetermined kata, in 4 min time. In the final phase (KO) competitors will present an enbu of five predetermined kata, in 6 min time.

d. For 10th Soryu Iaido Cup, Every team will represent its dojo and will be comprised by three players, with the possibility of one reserve (the summary of dan grades of performing members must not exceed 10 dan; Mudan is considered as 1 dan). Every dojo may be represented by two teams, of predetermined composition. There is possibility of mixed teams by players of different dojo. In every phase, Pools & KO, every competitor will perform an enbu of three kata, in four minutes time. Winning team is the one with the most wins in that particular match. In case a team is composed by two players only, the position of Chuken will remain vacant.

e. In Soryu Iaido Cup mixed teams may be composed for individual players who want to compete in the Taikai.

f. Use of sageo is obligatory.

g. Use of nafuda (zekken) is obligatory.

10. Registration:

11. Drawings

Drawings will take place on Thursday 30 March 2023 at 20:30 at Asunarokai Dojo, Megaloupoleos 9, Aghios Dimitrios. The presence of one representative by every participating club/dojo is allowed.

Meeting of participating teams' representatives will take place on Saturday 8 April 2023 at a place and time to be announced.

a. Grading is organized by Hellenic Kendo Iaido Jodo Naginata Federation, under EKF Rules.

b. Application for Grading, Closing date is **Monday 27 March 2023**. Registration should be made through EKF website by their relevant Federations.

c. Candidates should, on Saturday 8 April 2023, 15:00, provide to the HKINF Deputy Secretary, Christos Anagnostopoulos, valid HKINF Book (HKINF members), EKF Yellow Card (from 1 dan up), and pay the relevant Participation Fees.

d. Following the conduct of the grading, all successful candidates should, register their grading by paying the relevant Registration fees. Failing to register your successful grading will result in cancelation of your success.
